Safety Rules and Recommendations

General Rules

Safety is number one concern. Violators may be asked to leave parade!

Watch for children who may run out onto the parade route.

Attach the number of your float on the front and right side of the float.

Each entry must have one individual to walk along side their float

Stay a minimum of 50 feet behind float in front of you

NO THROWING WATER BALLOONS!!!!

Candy

Candy should be thrown in general direction of the curb.

Do not throw candy at anyone.

Do not drop candy near your float, especially in front or behind.

Do not throw candy from float to float.

Motorcycles & ATV's

Do not leave your designated line up position.

Be very aware of pedestrians and children

Dance Groups

Only stop once each way to dance.

Limit dances to 90 seconds.

Horses

Do not spray horses with water.

Do not honk horns or make loud noises around horses.

Do not throw candy around horses.

Groups are responsible for cleaning up after their horses

Horses will only go first half of the parade. They will not do the return route.
